



IATA e-freight: Scope of Documents





Common findings

- Develop own system to –
- Receive Shipper Letter of Instruction, Invoice, Packing List
- Copy the information from Shipper Letter of Instruction to House Air Waybill.
- Scan the image of Shipper Letter of Instruction, Invoice, Packing List, HAWB, MAWB, Cert. of Origin....for filing purpose.
- Scan the image of Invoice, Packing List, HAWB, MAWB, Cert. of Origin....to destination for pre-

CATHAY PACIFIC CARGO

alert and pre-Customs clearance purpose.



Document Pouch

- Only 10% 20% shipments required to forward original document to destination.
- Required to open the document pouch, due to insufficient information show on Air Waybill or House Manifest.
- Consignee not collect the document pouch upon flight arrival.
