Hong Kong International Airport has been subject to escalating interruption over the past two days. Hundreds of flights have been cancelled and airport operations have stalled, both of which have hindered air cargo operations.

If such disruption continues, it will undermine Hong Kong's reputation as an international transportation hub and the world's busiest cargo airport. It will have a far-reaching impact on Hong Kong and have a serious, adverse effect on the economy as a whole.

The Association respects the freedom to express opinions lawfully and peacefully. All parties must resolve their differences through rational dialogue and constructive communication so that society can restore peace and prosperity as soon as possible.
